Appeal Procedure:

All Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP's) are herewith informed that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of Chapter 2 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014).

Should any I&AP's wish to appeal any aspect of the decision, a notice of intention to appeal must be lodged by prospective appellants with the Minister, within 20 days of the date of the notification letter, by means of one of the following methods:
